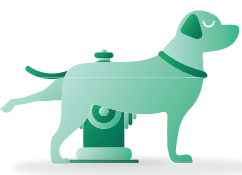


When I was diagnosed, my human and I did the reading. Pet diabetes is a group of conditions where a pet like me:

**Routine**

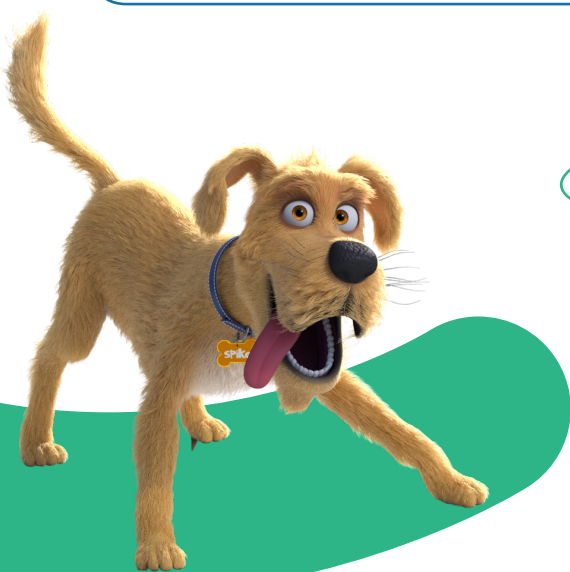


Regular meal times, regular exercise, daily insulin injections
